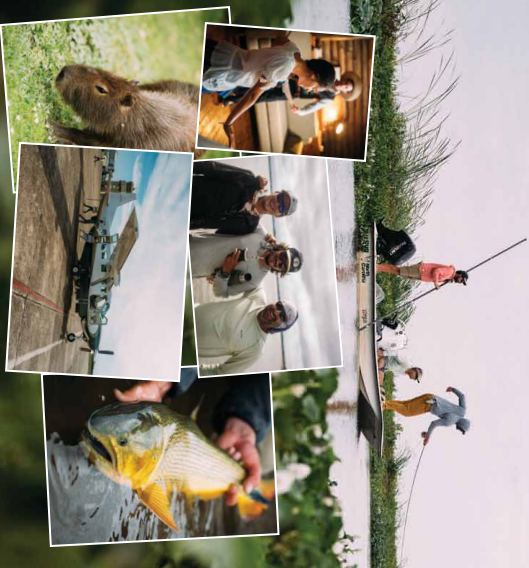

## Ysoro wetland & middle Paraná d river

### Action and fun

We heard golden dorado fishing can be elusive. At Jetu'u Lodge lies the tipping point for any angler unsure about embarking in this adventure. Perfect your casting and witness these 3-7 pound warriors erupt from the water in a dazzling display of power. It's a thrilling baptism by fire, preparing you for the true monsters that lurk just beyond.

The beauty of Jetu'u lies in its adaptability. This haven caters to all skill levels, whether you're a seasoned pro or a curious beginner. It's the perfect launching pad. Start by mastering dorado techniques before venturing to the giants at Iati Lodge. Headed to Iatena marsh? Don't miss the fun of the open waters of the Paraná's mid-section at Jetu'u!

Year-round accessibility. Enjoy short summer escapes or exciting winter cast-and-blast add-ons. No matter your travel plans, Jetu'u awaits.

#### The area

The Ysoro Marsh, pulsates with life. A natural nursery birthed from the splendor of the Paraná River, Golden dorado hone their fighting spirit in this fertile ecosystem where diverse wildlife make your visit unique and picturesque. Local "Pescanos" raising cattle and navigating among islands on wooden canoes bring a cobalt background.

Located halfway between the towns of Goya and Esquina it was declared a Province Natural Reserve in 2013. Short and direct connection with the main river creates a traffic of large golden dorado inside the wetlands especially when waters are dropping.

#### The fishing

Action guaranteed, giving you the chance to tune up with strip setting and acrobatic fights.

Lagoons and channels makes Ysoro Wetlands an intimate environment. Short distance casts, smaller flies, lighter rods and surf ace patterns make Jetu'u such a friendly fishery for all anglers no matter skill levels. 16' skiffs with casting platforms at bow and stern allows 2 anglers to fish simultaneously. Guide maneuvers to the perfect spot with remote control Minnicra Motors.

Encounter: Pacu, Piria-pira, wolf fish (tararai), pyrraha (palometa) and beautiful tiger spotted catfish (surubi)



#### The lodge

Jetu'u is a large log cabin lodge with 4 rooms that accommodates 8 anglers. Every room is aligned to the gallery where the outdoor breakfast area allows the day to start looking at the Ysoro Wetland and the skiff only 50 yards away. The main dining room and bar are home for cocktail happy hours every day before dinner. Jetu'u special charm welcomes our guests to the local culture and traditions.

# Itati Lodge

## Upper parana

### Golden trophy of a lifetime

Home of the largest golden dorado on the planet, were it all started, the Upper Parana River is the destination where anglers have the opportunity to connect with a lifetime TROPHY.

At Itati lodge focus is the name of the game, each and every cast might be it each every strip can hide the monster, be ready be there

Another feature of the Upper Parana River is the possibility of targeting Pacu and pirapira under jungle trees hanging over the banks.

### The Area

Upper Parana starts as tall water of Yacoyeta Dam and flows for 135 miles until the junction with Paraguay River. The clearest water conditions you can encounter anywhere in the Parana making it ideal for fly fishing. The most productive spawning area of the system allows older resident fish to live year round and migratory fish that arrive for the spawn.

### The Fishing

Parana is a river so huge that might intimidate anglers, but it presents very enticing and super varied structures

where we target these dorados. The big ones use a lot of rock structure to ambush their prey fish, the sabalo. Rocky banks and islands are our favorite places to target them. Sandbars with light coloration, cutbanks and island points where jungle trees have fallen into the waters are great too.

Pacu and Pira Piria action is out there for the taking, a fun break to heavy #8 adding more fish species to your list. 17' skiff boats with platforms at bow and stern making two anglers to fish simultaneously. Boats are equipped with 100 HP outboard and a Minn Kota 80 lbs at bow which is remote controlled by guides to hold position in the hot spot we are targeting. Additionally guides may use a push pole while fishing the flats.

### The Lodge

Placed on an elevated bank that overlooks the Parana, Itati Lodge offers accommodations in 6 rooms for 30 anglers. Dining room size inspired by the river where breakfast, lunch and dinners are served will not go unseen. Our guests enjoy an entertainment night by local musicians and dancers performing Charrino, the regional folk music.



Short 50 yards walk of "frame or shame" from your room to the Skiff with a short boat ride to the best action spots. The lodge is conveniently located 40 min away from Corrientes CNG airport

## Ibera Wetlands Reserve Wild and Pristine

"Ibera" means "shiny water" in Guarani. Thousands of years ago, the Parana River dramatically changed course, leaving behind a vast freshwater treasure. Rainfall brought life to this unique ecosystem, inspiring myths and legends. We're honored to be the only outfitter in Argentina's newest national park, protecting this pristine wilderness.

### The Avea

Ibera, the world's second-largest freshwater aquifer, rivals the Everglades in size. Crystal-clear waters and untouched landscapes make it a paradise for bird-watchers and wildlife enthusiasts. We operate in 70% of the Avea system, offering an exclusive experience.

### The Fishing

Imagine targeting Golden Dorado in a maze of clear-water channels; an intimate and unforgettable experience. Expect plentiful medium-sized fish (4-8 lbs) with chances of trophy catches (15-20 lbs). We use small, maneuverable skiffs with guides poling from the stern.

### The Lodge

La Alondra*i*, a historic, 100-year-old house, lies in Concepcion del Yaguarete area, offering a glimpse into Gaucho culture. Restored to its former glory, it features 6 spacious rooms that open to a gallery over a central yard. Two different dining rooms give ambiance for breakfast and dinners. Local artisans and musicians regularly visit the lodge to bring cultural immersion and entertainment to the lodge.

### The Camps within the Ibera marsh

The marsh is so vast and intricate that after months of scouting and exploring, searching for the best program, fishing and meeting locals, sharing and helping, we realized that what we were doing was exactly the best experience possible. It was a revelation.

"Ibera Riquia" is the Base Camp. Omar's cabin, local palisano, true estero, we are lucky to be friends with and enjoy his hospitality. 2 double rooms and 2 single rooms with shared bathroom power light in the middle of the

marsh. Ibera riquia literally means "Deep in the marsh", truly unbelievable.

2 satellite tent camps: "El Disparro" and "Yaguarete Avea" take the experience to the next level and allow you to fish new water every day, fish further every day, fish it all...no impossible. We don't lose time back and forth and we don't disturb the overwhelming spirit of the Ibera marsh
